



#### Q.6: In how many of your classes ...do your teachers have high expectations for you?









Q.7: In how many of your classes ...do your teachers ask difficult questions on tests?




Q.8: In how many of your classes ...do your teachers ask difficult questions in class?










Q.1: Adults at this school communicate with me in a language that I can understand.







#### Q.2: I feel safe...outside around this school.
















# Q.7: During this school year, I have felt worried when learning.
