- Support a school culture of high academic standards and behavioral standards grounded in restorative practices, with the aim of creating a supportive and engaging learning environment.
- Create a year-long curriculum that utilizes limited classroom/gym space

- NYS teaching certification or eligibility to be certified
- Ability to work as part of a high performing team, including exceptional communication and organizational skills
- Desire to work in an urban middle school, experience in NYC preferred
- Demonstrated belief that all children deserve an excellent education
- Ability to work in an environment with limited space
